Introducing Nagasaki Ropeway & Inasayama

Inasayama (Mt. Inasa) is a 333 meter high mountain that offers great views of the Nagasaki's city center. When the weather is clear, you can see as far as Unzendake or Goto.

The round mountaintop observatory offers an amazing scenic view that is virtually a 360 degree aerial take on the city and its beautiful surrounding that changes from season to season.

The highlight of Nagasaki tour is when the sun turns the sea into orange color during sunset and the "Ten Million Dollar Night Views" where thousand lights sparkle like jewels.

You can also see fireworks on the best seat during summer time.

It takes about five minutes to reach the top of the mountain through the ropeway. You can enjoy the beautiful scenery of Nagasaki while
